

STEPS TO ARRANGE LODGING

If you live 90 kilometres or more from GRRCC, hotel lodging is available at no cost to you

Steps to arranging lodging:

When you have your treatment plan appointment with your care team:

- You will get a list of your appointment dates and times
- contact the Lodging Team (details on back of pamphlet) and they will assist you
- You will be asked:
 - Town where you live
 - Date and time of your first treatment
 - Total number of treatments
 - If a friend or family member will stay in the hotel with you
 - If you need an accessible room

Once lodging is arranged, you will receive an email with all the details.

Patients receiving chemotherapy and/or radiation treatment, who live more than 90 kilometres from the Grand River Regional Cancer Centre can benefit from local lodgings at no cost.

This benefit is funded by our generous donors through the Grand River Hospital Foundation.

Our Preferred Hotel

We have a plan with a hotel in Kitchener. The staff at the hotel welcome everyone and do all they can to meet the needs of our patients as their guests.

Based on a room for one or two people, included in your stay are

- Rooms for people with disabilities
- Breakfast
- Parking
- Wi-Fi (internet access)
- Mini fridge, microwave and coffee maker

Lodging is scheduled around treatment appointments from Monday to Friday (excluding statutory holidays).

About the Foundation

Grand River Hospital Foundation raises money to help Grand River Hospital provide exceptional health care. The foundation is led by a volunteer Board of Governors and run by staff, who work with the hospital's leadership team to learn about patient needs and how their support can improve patient experience and care.

With the help of generous donors, supporters and community partners, the foundation raises millions of dollars for the hospital each year. This money is used to pay for medical equipment, programs and other initiatives that are not funded by the government or other sources. This includes paying for lodging for cancer patients who live outside the Waterloo Wellington area.



Is there a discount for patients with cancer at the hotel?

There is no cost to you as a patient of the GRRCC.

Can my family member / friend stay with me? How much does that cost?

There is no cost to a family member or friend staying at the hotel with you in the same room.

I don't have anyone to take care of my pet while I'm away. Can I bring them with me?

Patients can pay an extra fee to bring a pet with them. Contact the hotel for restrictions and costs. Service animals with registration stay free of charge.

Can I check into the hotel on Sunday?

The hotel stay is for the actual day(s) of your treatment. Check-in is usually on a Monday and check-out on Friday. You can pay an additional charge to check in or out sooner. Contact the hotel to make these arrangements. You will be billed for any extra days.
